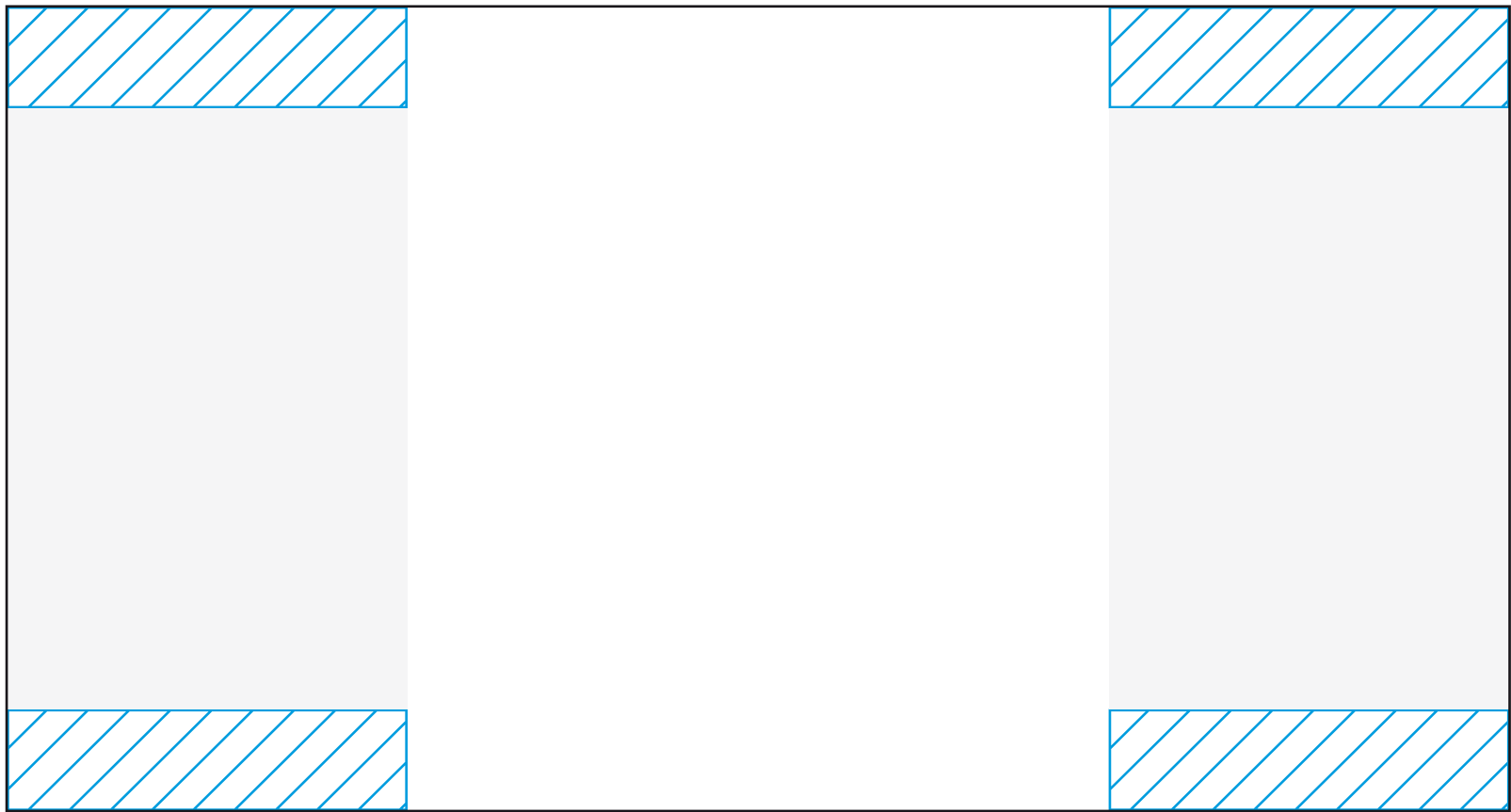


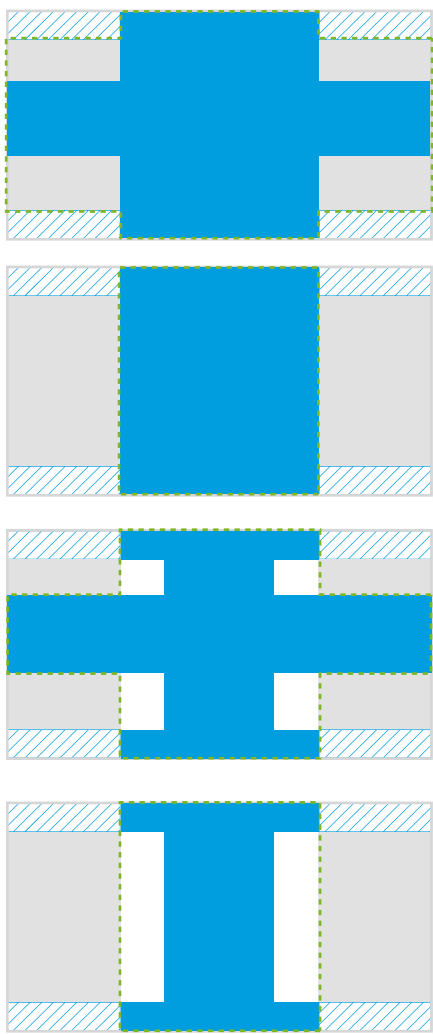
# Vectortuts+ Totem Project: Artwork Guide



## Guidelines:

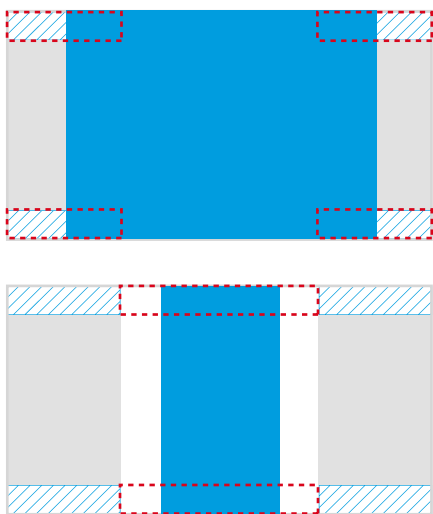
- Artwork can be any style or theme as long as it's vector and 100% your own work.
- You don't have to spend hours and hours on your piece, the project's aim is to be fun, fast and individual.
- You may submit more than one design as long as you let us know what order they stack in.
- The final image must be a 600px by 320px 72dpi RGB Jpg (to fit our blog template).
- When you publish your work on Flickr, please include one or two paragraphs about yourself and/or your work and a link to your website/online portfolio.
- Make sure to add your final artwork to the Vectortuts+ Flickr Group and add the tag "vectortuts totem" to your image data.

## Do



- ✓ You can put side parts on the design.
- ✓ Or, you can fill the entire middle area.
- ✓ You can keep parts of the middle section clear of illustration as long as the top and bottom parts remain.
- ✓ You don't need side details (in the grey area), these are optional

## Don't



- ✗ Image must not be outside the template. The four outer corners should remain clear.
- ✗ The top and bottom sections must be covered so that the images can "stack" as a Totem.

### Terms

- \*Artwork must follow the project guidelines
- \*You can't use stock images or copyright material in your creations, this includes trademarks, logos and "free" vector downloads. The work you submit to this project must be 100% your own.
- \*By submitting your work you agree to the above terms and give Tuts+ permission to use your image for publishing and promotional purposes.
- \* Not all submitted work will be published, each submissions will be reviewed by Tuts+ staff.
- \*Each design can only be submitted once, multiple and revised designs can be submitted.
